Jupiter Medical Center's Intensive Care Unit (ICU) And Progressive Care Unit (PCU) Welcomes You! We Offer Help And Support To You And Your Family.

We recognize the importance of family involvement and your support during recovery. We encourage you to turn to us if you have any questions or concerns. We are here to help lessen the impact of this health crisis on the patient and family.

While we recognize the importance of providing all of our patients' families with important information, our first priority is the care of our patients.

We ask each patient's family to identify one spokesperson as a link between the ICU/PCU team and family members when contacting the ICU/PCU by phone.

Thank you for your cooperation.

Because of the medical care given in our ICU/PCU, this area has a more restricted visitation policy. Special guidelines for patient visitation are as follows:

- Visiting times are limited to ensure our critical care patients have a quiet environment and adequate rest to aid in their recovery.

- Only two visitors (immediate family or significant other) are permitted at the patient's bedside.
- Children under the age of 14 years old are not permitted to visit.
- PLEASE DO NOT EAT OR DRINK IN PATIENT ROOMS.
- Live plants and flowers are not permitted.
- All visitors are asked to check with the nurse prior to visiting. Exceptions to this policy will be granted at the discretion of the nurse.



- If you have a cold or flu, please refrain from visiting.
- It is our duty to protect the privacy of all our patients, so we ask that all visitors please remain in their family member's room during visits, and refrain from roaming the hallway.
- Telephones are available for visitor use in the ICU/PCU Family Waiting Room. Phones at the nurses' desk must remain available to the nursing and physician staff.

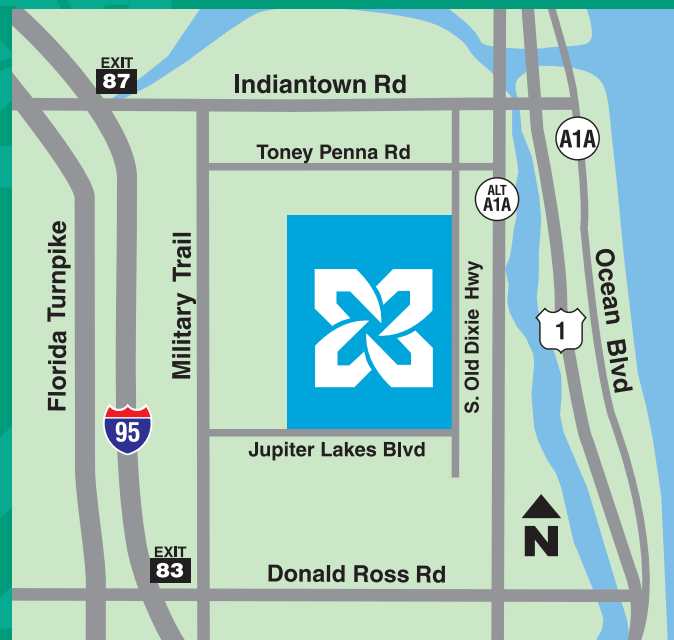

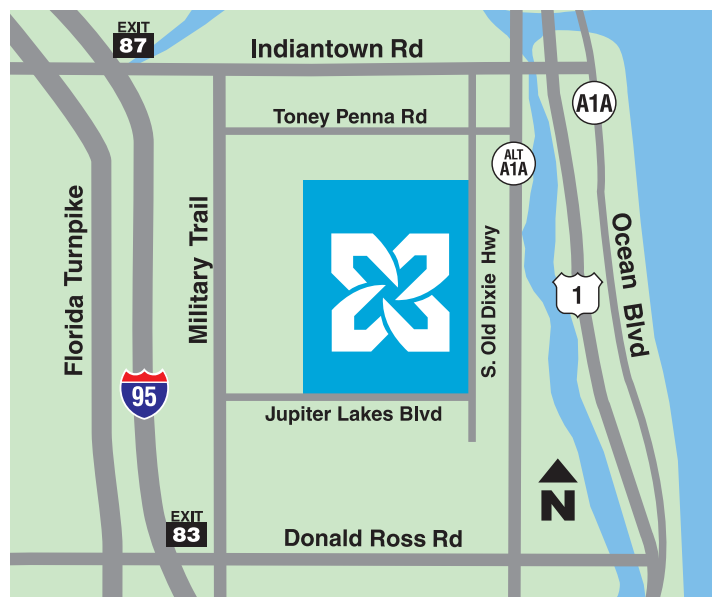
