

Forging the Future of Cancer Care Here and Now

The Anderson Family Cancer Institute at Jupiter Medical Center has seen an extraordinary year of groundbreaking procedures and therapies. Our multispecialty team of experts includes surgical, medical, and radiation oncologists who offer life-saving treatments for our cancer patients.

LIFE-SAVING SURGERY FOR PANCREATIC CANCER

Jupiter Medical Center continues to lead the way in advanced surgical robotics. Dr. Shanel Bhagwandin, Medical Director of the Gastrointestinal Surgical Oncology Program and Program Director of the National Pancreas Foundation Center of Excellence, performed the first robotic Whipple surgery for pancreatic cancer in the region in August.

The use of surgical robots to assist with complex procedures, such as the Whipple, has been associated with improved patient outcomes and accelerated patient healing, so that patients can more quickly get back to the life they love.

Dr. Bhagwandin is a highly sought-after leader in gastrointestinal surgeries, boasting the highest volume for liver, pancreas, gastric, and esophageal procedures in the region, both open and robotic.

INNOVATIVE TREATMENT FOR LUNG TUMORS

We are excited to be one of the first hospitals in the United States to use a promising new, minimally invasive treatment, pulsed field ablation, for lung tumors. Dr. Kevin Green, Pulmonologist, specializing in advanced interventional bronchoscopic procedures, and Dr. K. Adam Lee, Cardiothoracic Surgeon and Medical Director of the Thoracic Surgery & Lung Center of Excellence, performed the procedure using the Galvanize Therapeutics Aliya™ PEF System.

PEF ablation is a minimally invasive procedure performed during a bronchoscopy. During the procedure, a needle is passed into the tumor, which delivers short pulses of electrical current, destroying the tumor without damaging healthy tissue. This technology enables us to be very precise in the area we target and also mobilizes the body's immune system to fight the tumor. Patients may experience little or no pain and a quicker recovery compared to traditional surgical approaches.

This groundbreaking procedure combines the advanced expertise of our specialists with the latest therapeutic innovations. With the introduction of PEF ablation for lung tumors, Jupiter Medical Center continues to lead in medical advancements, offering renewed hope and enhanced outcomes for our patients.

TARGETED THERAPY FOR BLADDER CANCER

At Jupiter Medical Center we are witnessing the future of cancer care. We are proud to be among the first in the region to administer first-in-class gene therapy for bladder cancer. ADSTILADRIN® (nadofaragene firdadeni-ove-vrcg) is the first and only FDA-approved gene therapy for non-muscle-invasive bladder cancer.

The new therapy targets cancer cells more precisely by delivering adenoviral vector-based gene therapy directly into the bladder, prompting the production of an immune-stimulating protein, harnessing the body's natural immune response and offering patients the best possible outcomes.

NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED CARE

Thanks to our committed team and their dedication to quality, Jupiter Medical Center continues to earn national recognition for breast care. The National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers (NAPBC), a quality program administered by the American College of Surgeons (ACS) has once again accredited our Comprehensive Breast Care Program. Jupiter Medical Center was the first breast center in Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast region to be accredited by NAPBC in 2010. Our continued accreditation is emblematic of our commitment to providing best-in-class breast care in our region.





A Year of Innovation in Heart and Vascular Care

Jupiter Medical Center proudly reflects on a transformative year at the Robson Heart and Vascular Institute, highlighting significant advancements in cardiac care through the introduction of innovative technologies and procedures that uphold our standard of excellence.

EXPANSION OF ROBOTIC CARDIAC SURGERY

Under the leadership of Dr. Vivek Patel, cardiovascular surgeon, the cardiac robotic surgery program has expanded, marking a significant leap forward in state-of-the-art cardiac care. This program utilizes advanced robotic technology to provide greater precision and minimally invasive surgical options, fully aligned with our mission to enhance patient outcomes and reduce recovery times. Our highly skilled surgical team is dedicated to adopting these cutting-edge techniques, ensuring we remain at the forefront of cardiac surgery.

AI TOOLS FOR CUSTOMIZED CARDIAC TREATMENT PLANS

The integration of artificial intelligence (AI) into cardiovascular imaging continues to revolutionize our approach to patient care. We have incorporated AI-assisted analysis in coronary computed tomography angiography (CCTA) to precisely identify and quantify plaque accumulation while distinguishing hard from soft plaques, which is crucial for prevention. Our cardiac specialists leverage this technology to develop personalized treatment strategies, empowering patients to manage their health proactively through lifestyle modifications and medication plans. Customized plans address each patient's unique health needs and significantly reduce the risk of heart attacks, strokes, and sudden cardiac events.

INTRODUCING PIONEERING TREATMENTS

We are thrilled to introduce the Concomitant Procedure, a groundbreaking minimally invasive intervention for select patients with atrial fibrillation (AFib), which is characterized by an irregular heart rhythm. This innovative approach delivers successful treatment in a single outpatient visit rather than two separate procedures, months apart. Spearheaded by Dr. David Weisman, our director of cardiac electrophysiology, this initiative combines atrial fibrillation ablation with WATCHMAN device implantation to prevent strokes.

Traditionally, AFib patients faced the challenge of two invasive procedures: one to restore normal heart rhythm and the other for WATCHMAN implantation. This two-step process not only extended the treatment timeline but also increased risks and prolonged recovery periods. The Concomitant Procedure streamlines treatment, improving operational efficiency, reducing patient strain, allowing for a quicker return to daily activities, and enhancing overall quality of life.

We are also integrating the VARIPULSE Pulsed Field Ablation system to refine our AFib treatments. This advanced technology improves the precision of ablation procedures for AFib and other rhythm disorders by delivering controlled energy pulses that specifically target and ablate abnormal heart tissue with minimal damage to surrounding healthy tissue, reducing recovery times and the risk of complications. The system's real-time imaging capabilities allow our physicians to visualize the heart's anatomy during procedures, ensuring effectiveness and providing an added layer of safety.

Our structural heart program continues to lead the way with the introduction of the TriClip procedure. This minimally invasive transcatheter heart valve repair is used to treat tricuspid regurgitation, a condition caused by a leaky tricuspid valve, in select patients. The procedure involves inserting a clip via a catheter through a vein and guiding it to the heart to bring the valve's leaflets together, thereby reducing blood leakage. Under the guidance of Dr. Michael Sabbah, this less-invasive alternative to open-heart surgery enables patients to return home faster.

LOOKING AHEAD: COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE

As we celebrate our achievements from the past year, our Heart and Vascular team remains steadfast in advancing cardiac care. By leveraging AI in imaging analysis, integrating pioneering technologies such as the VARIPULSE system, and mastering transformative procedures like the Concomitant Procedure, we are reshaping the landscape of heart and vascular care. Together, we look forward to another year of groundbreaking advancements.

ADVANCED TECHNOLOGIES—DRIVEN BY PASSION

At the Anderson Family Orthopedic and Spine Center of Excellence, technology, innovation, and the expertise of our top clinicians converge to provide exceptional care. Our cutting-edge robotic solutions, including the CORI™ robotic-assisted surgical system, Mako SmartRobotics™, and VELYS™ robotic-assisted solutions, cater to a variety of orthopedic surgical applications—from knees, to hips, to shoulders, and beyond. These advancements offer patients an unprecedented range of options to regain mobility and enhance their quality of life without the prolonged recovery periods typically associated with conventional methods.

Our expert clinicians are committed to mastering these innovative robotic solutions, as ongoing clinical practice reveals their effectiveness in reducing pain and accelerating recovery. Our team's approach combining preoperative rehabilitation with the CORI system has enabled many patients to be discharged on the same day or the next day after knee replacement surgery.

Earlier this year, we proudly introduced the region's first robotic shoulder replacement, expanding our advanced orthopedic robotic arm-assisted offerings beyond hip and knee procedures. This positions Jupiter Medical Center as a regional leader in orthopedic care. Utilizing Mako SmartRobotics™, this surgery integrates CT-based 3D planning with intra-operative guidance to accurately map a patient's unique bone structure and alignment, facilitating the creation of anatomically comparable or enhanced replacement joints. The Mako system allows for precise adjustments and placements of prosthetics in real time during surgery.

COMPREHENSIVE PATIENT CARE

Achieving the best outcomes for patients requires a holistic approach, which is why we have invested in multiple robotic systems, each with distinct advantages. Our focus on a team-based approach to orthopedics ensures that every patient receives a procedure tailored to their unique physiology and lifestyle. After the procedure, rehabilitation is a vital component of successful recovery. Jupiter Medical Center's rehabilitation services encompass a comprehensive program staffed by licensed, experienced clinical professionals, including physical, occupational, and speech therapists, many

with specialized certifications. Our team also includes exercise specialists and massage therapists proficient in alleviating pain and restoring function.

Advancing Stroke Care Through Cutting-edge Technology and Exceptional Clinical Expertise

Offering top-tier stroke care, combining compassion with innovation

INNOVATIVE CARE FOR THE MOST COMPLEX CASES

At Jupiter Medical Center, stroke treatment begins the moment symptoms are recognized. Our multidisciplinary team delivers timely, evidence-based care for cases ranging from mild to complex. Working closely with first responders and using advanced imaging and treatment technology, we focus on improving recovery and minimizing long-term effects—because every minute matters.

Our team's comprehensive approach to stroke care enables us to manage high-severity, complex cases:

- Advanced imaging including 3T MRI and CT capabilities
- Neurointerventional radiology expertise
- Rapid Response Team for early intervention and timely care
- Neurological Intensive Care for critical care

While expedited intervention is vital, we recognize that recovery can be a gradual process. Our commitment to excellence in stroke care extends beyond immediate treatment, leveraging a multi-disciplinary team of compassionate experts. Our physical, occupational, and speech language therapists, along with aquatic and exercise specialists, employ innovative therapies and treatment modalities to enhance quality of life for stroke survivors.

CUTTING EDGE TECHNOLOGIES BOLSTER AN EXCEPTIONAL PROGRAM

Jupiter Medical Center proudly became the first in South Florida to implement the Neuroguard IEP® system for carotid artery disease (CAD), a condition that narrows the carotid arteries on either side of the neck that carry blood to the brain and accounts for a third of all stroke cases. This first-in-class, FDA-approved medical device reduces the chance of stroke during and after the procedure to treat carotid artery disease.

EXPANDING ACCESS TO ADVANCED IMAGING CARE

A transformative \$5 million gift from Dorothy J. Thomson is supporting the expansion of The Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center, strengthening its role as the region's leading destination for breast health and advanced imaging services. Dorothy's generosity is a deeply personal tribute, inspired by her own breast cancer journey and the compassionate care she received at the Center.

Since opening in 2015, the Niedland Breast Center has become the cornerstone of women's imaging at Jupiter Medical Center, providing nearly 40,000 exams annually with leading technologies including 3D mammography, breast MRI, ultrasound, and image-guided biopsy. Rapid community growth has significantly increased demand, resulting in extended wait times for services that are essential to early detection and timely diagnosis.

To meet this need, Jupiter Medical Center will expand the Center by adding a dedicated 13,000-square-foot imaging wing that will serve patients across the region. The addition will include new CT scanners, expanded ultrasound capacity, a second MRI, additional mammography suites, an outpatient laboratory, and space to support integrative mindfulness programs that promote comfort and healing.

In recognition of Dorothy's extraordinary commitment, the Center's new lobby and healing garden will be named in her honor—spaces that reflect her belief in compassionate, patient-first care. Her generosity ensures that more individuals will receive timely, high-quality imaging and diagnostic services, strengthening our ability to provide exceptional care when it matters most.

ELEVATING CLINICAL EXCELLENCE THROUGH SIMULATION

Forward-thinking gifts from Alta and Peter Hamilton and The Booth Foundation are helping to establish Jupiter Medical Center's state-of-the-art Center for Clinical Simulation in the new Patient Care Tower. This advanced training environment will strengthen the skills of nurses, physicians, and allied health professionals across multiple specialties, ensuring that every patient benefits from highly prepared, confident, and collaborative care teams.

The Center will feature three lifelike simulation suites and a dedicated 30-person simulation classroom, offering immersive learning experiences in nursing, emergency medicine, surgery, anesthesia, pediatrics, obstetrics and gynecology, and more. Through hands-on training with high-fidelity mannequins, specialized task trainers, virtual reality, and standardized patients, clinicians will practice decision-

making, technical skills, communication, and teamwork in a safe, controlled environment that mirrors real clinical scenarios.

This cutting-edge facility will be fully equipped with hospital-grade beds, monitors, defibrillators, medication prep areas, and advanced recording technology that allows instructors to observe, assess, and debrief each session. Simulators respond with human-like accuracy, enabling clinicians to learn from complex situations – from cardiac events to stroke care to labor and delivery – without risk to actual patients.

As demand for clinical experience grows and healthcare becomes increasingly complex, simulation-based education is essential to developing skilled, compassionate clinicians who are prepared for every situation. The generosity of the Hamilton family and The Booth Foundation ensures that Jupiter Medical Center can deliver this elevated standard of training, strengthening the quality and safety of care throughout our institution.
